- 2. The number of hours that transfer towards your degree will be posted and available in the Student Records Office by the end of your first semester.**
- 3. Students should run their degree audit on Ram Link. When student has completed 90 hours, a degree audit will be processed by Office of Student Records. Direct any questions regarding degree audit to the Office of Student Records.**
- 4. All students must see their academic advisor prior to each registration (name and telephone number are indicated on this worksheet.)**
- 5. A minimum of 45 hours or 25% of the credit hours (whichever is greater) of a degree must be earned at Texas Wesleyan University. Twenty-four (24) of the 45 hours must be of junior or senior level. A minimum of 15 upper division hours in the major field must be earned at Texas Wesleyan University. A major in a department or school must be completed with a minimum grade point average of 2.0. A higher grade point average may be required by certain departments. A student should consult with her/his major advisor and the University catalog regarding specific requirements for the major.**
- 6. While earning a baccalaureate degree from Texas Wesleyan University, a maximum of 30 hours will be allowed for correspondence courses, AP tests and CLEP tests. No more than one-fourth of the requirements for a major subject may be completed by these courses. AP tests, CLEP tests, correspondence courses, waivers and/or substitutions will not count as part of the 45-hour residency requirement.**
