The Texas Wesleyan Theatre Department is happy to know of your interest in our program and would like to invite you to schedule your appointment for an audition/interview. Below are details about that process. The finalization of the date is dependent upon the faculty's availability. Since these auditions are set on a first come, first served basis, we suggest you make your appointment as soon as possible.

It is our policy to hold auditions and interviews for prospective students on Tuesdays or Thursdays to allow you to visit with our professors, students and attend theatre classes. If your schedule permits, we have a full agenda so you can experience most, if not all, of our department and campus. Upon your arrival, we'll meet in my office located in the Dan Waggoner Annex Building, Room 100A. (Building 27 on the enclosed campus map.) We invite you to sit in on our Tech II class beginning at 9:25am and our Acting II class at 10:50am. If you plan on attending classes we ask that you arrive by 9:00am. Afterward, you're welcome to dine with a few of our students in Dora's Café on the campus. Your Audition/ Interview will start at approximately 1:00pm. After your audition, you're free to enjoy the rest of our campus. We recommend you visit Admissions to make sure all applications and paperwork are complete and up to date. If you have not yet applied to the University, that would be an opportune time to do so. We also recommend you take a tour of the campus, which we can set up for you upon request. We look forward to your visit.

**TECHNICAL emphasis will need to prepare:**

A Portfolio or Display

*Please keep in mind, Technical interviews are conducted in our theatre offices, not the theatre space; you will not have access to any equipment i.e. soundboard, light board, mannequin, etc.*
