

24-25 Family Contribution Appeal (Professional Judgement/Special Circumstances)

There are instances when a student's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) may not reflect the family's current situation. These are special circumstances that can be considered that may impact the student's financial aid eligibility. In these rare cases, a financial aid administrator may exercise professional judgment to adjust data that determines the student's Student Aid Index (SAI) and/or Cost of Attendance components. There must be a significant change to the family's income to be considered for a Professional Judgment. Students who already have a SAI of -1500 or zero (0) per their FAFSA should not apply for a professional judgment as this type of change will have no impact on fund eligibility

Professional Judgment appeals are reviewed on a case-by-case basis and *require a letter of explanation and supporting documentation*. You must submit all required documentation in order for the Professional Judgment to be reviewed.
