

2023-24 Texas Equalization Grant (TEG) Hardship Provisions - Appeal for State Funding

HARDSHIP PROVISIONS (19 TAC, SECTION 22.27) A student who is ineligible for a TEG award based on grade point average (GPA), completion rate, or number of completed hours for satisfactory academic progress, or enrollment less than three-quarter time *may be deemed eligible under a hardship provision*.

Texas Wesleyan University (TxWES) reserves the right to approve or deny any student's Hardship Appeal. If the TEG allocation for the academic year has been exhausted at the time that the Hardship Appeal is submitted, the appeal cannot be granted due to the absence of funding.

To maintain your State TEG Grant, you must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA along with a 75 percent completion rate of all of the courses that you have attempted. *The maximum amount of time that you may receive TEG is five (5) years*.
